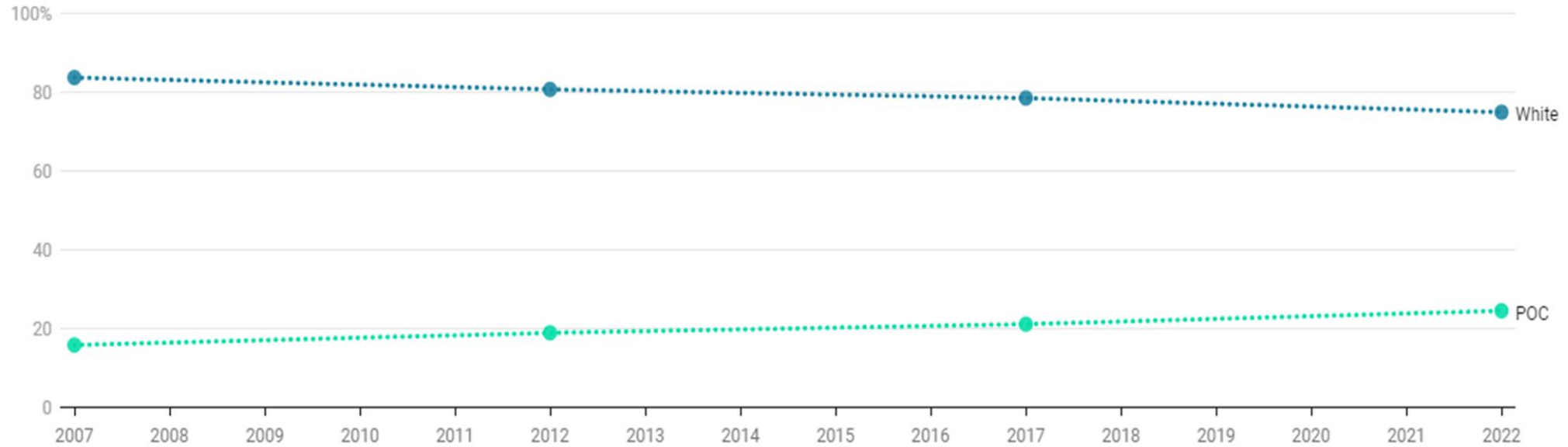


Career SES by Race

In 2007, people of color made up 16% of career SES. By 2022, this number had increased to 24.7%.



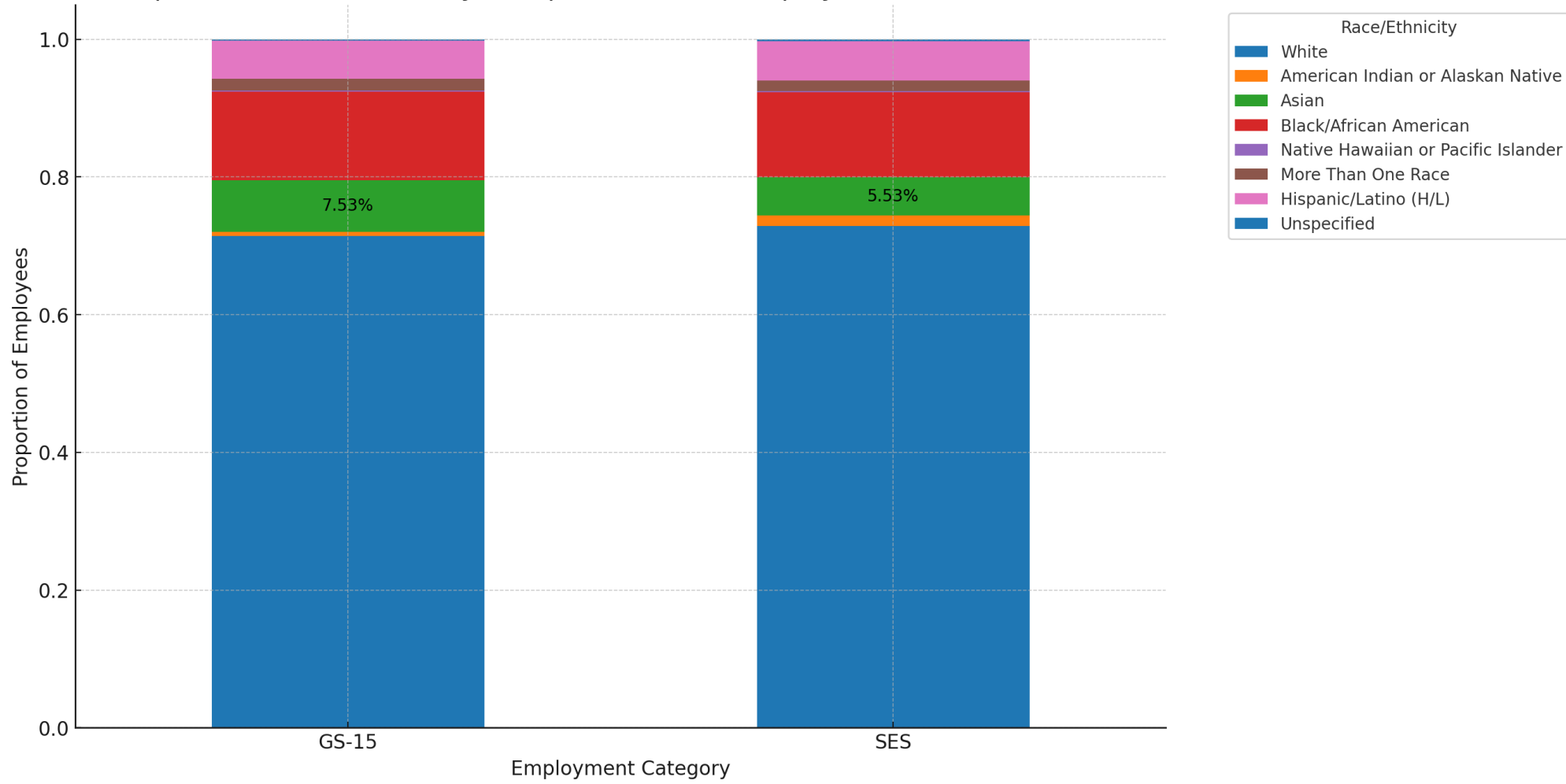

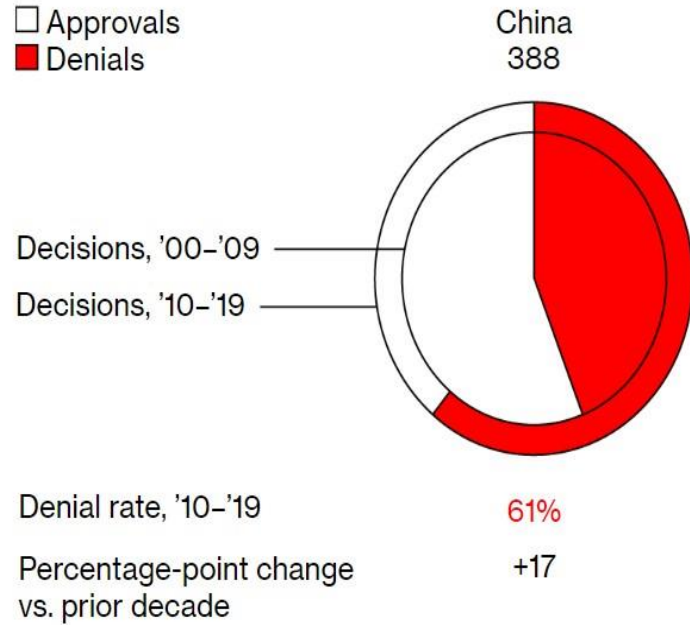
Proportion of Race/Ethnicity Groups in Selected Employment (GS-15 and SES)
